

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-0411-Contractors Registration

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HARDIN, TEXAS; REQUIRING THE REGISTRATION OF CONTRACTORS TO PERFORM WORK WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING A PENALTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Hardin, Texas, (“the city”) finds that the best interest of the citizens of the City of Hardin is to have contractors performing work within the City to notify and register with the City Secretary;  
NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council enacts the following ordinance:

Section 1. All contractors and subcontractors must register with the city annually. This registration shall be satisfied by completing the Contractor Registration Application with the City Secretary which shall include:

- a. Applicant’s Name
- b. Applicant’s Business Address
- c. Name of Property Owner
- d. List of valid licenses held by applicant
- e. License number(s) held by applicant as issued from the applicable licensing agency or authority
- f. A Certificate of Insurance currently in effect demonstrating a minimum general liability coverage level of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00).

Section 2. Except for master plumbers, all contractors and subcontractors must pay a \$25.00 annual registration fee.

Section 3. A violation of this ordinance is punishable by a fine no less than \$50.00 and no more than \$500.00

This ordinance takes full force and effect once signed by the mayor, attested by the city secretary, and duly published in the newspaper of record.
